DENTAL ESTIMATES

The development of Veterinary Dentistry as a specialty has been extraordinarily rapid. Cavities can now be filled; broken teeth can now be saved; and gum surgery can stabilize teeth that, in the past, would have been lost. Since all dental procedures require anesthesia, it is desirable to complete as many treatment procedures as possible during one anesthetic episode. It is also necessary to state that a complete examination of the teeth and gums is impossible until the patient has been anesthetized and the teeth have been cleaned, charted and x-rayed. We do not know in advance what treatment procedures will be necessary.

Therefore, the following fee quotes are estimates for routine procedures. We request that you leave a phone number where you can be reached to discuss additional procedures, if necessary.

If we cannot reach you, no major additional therapies will be performed; however, minor procedures deemed appropriate will be performed and will alter your estimated charges, unless you specifically direct us not to do so.
